



STUSU Motions CASA AGM November, 2009

Motion 1: Canadian Student Survey

Whereas CASA has committed \$30,000 to fund a Canadian Student Survey; and

Whereas there is no line in the 2009–2010 budget distributed to members with \$30,000 that could be used to fund a Canadian Student Survey; and

Whereas at the 2009 Policy and Strategy conference, the surplus was allocated towards a contingency fund and ensuring French translation was available at conferences; and

Whereas the general assembly has not voted to allocate any money towards a Canadian Student Survey;

Therefore be it resolved that the National Director and Chair provide members with an up-to-date copy of the budget and a written explanation of where the \$30,000 for the Canadian Student Survey is coming from and how the decision to fund it was made.

Motion 2: Posting of records

Whereas in June 2009 the general assembly passed a motion reading in part: “CASA post all documents from its conferences, committee meetings, and conference calls including, but not limited to agenda, minutes, briefing notes, and member reviews in a visible and accessible area on the website in a timely manner (except in cases where confidentiality must be maintained)”; and

Whereas minutes have not been posted on the website or circulated to members; and

Whereas posting records increases communication and transparency;

Therefore be it resolved that CASA make every effort to abide by the motion “posting of records” passed by the general assembly at the 2009 policy and strategy conference.
